



How do I find my Transit Number, Financial Institution Number and Account Number?

To find your Branch, look at an Account Statement (physical or electronic). There will be a line that clarifies which Branch you are registered with.

TRANSIT NUMBER

Depending on the Branch listed on your Account Statement, it will have one of the following codes:

- 06610 – Sechelt
- 06620 - Gibsons
- 06630 – Pender Harbor

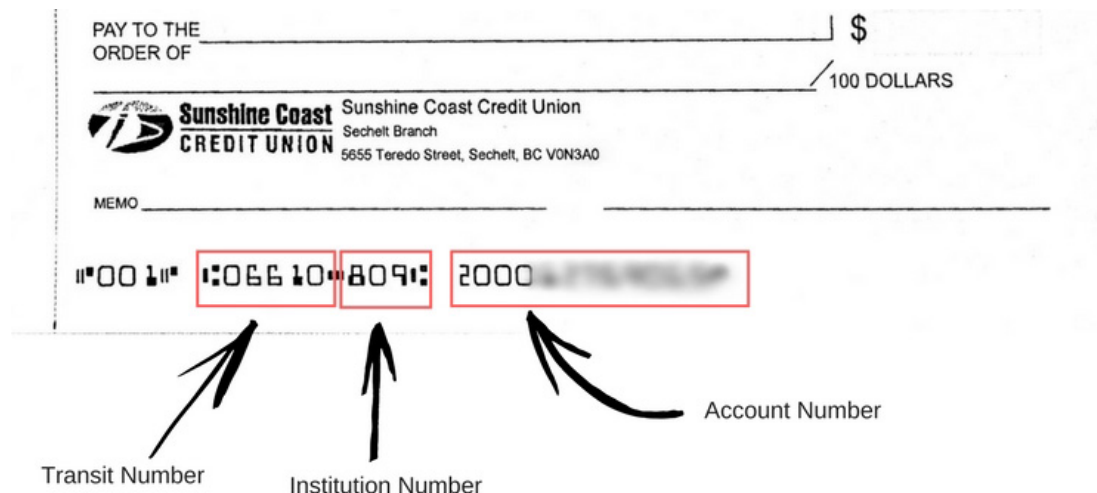
FINANCIAL INSTITUTION NUMBER

Sunshine Coast Credit Union’s Institution Number is 809 or 0809 in some cases.

ACCOUNT NUMBER

Your Account Number will be the long 12 digit number which begins with 2000.

This can also be found on your Account Statement (physical or electronic) and on any of your Sunshine Coast Credit Union Cheques.



What is my Financial Institutions SWIFT code?

SWIFT code for all other foreign currency incoming wires & for CAD incoming from outside of Canada
