### **1. How to Enter**

- There is no entry fee and no purchase is necessary to enter this Contest.
- LIMIT one (1) entry per person.
- Contest closing date: In order to be eligible for the Contest, entries must be received by SCCU through an in-person ballot by July 31<sup>st</sup> 2015 6pm Vancouver BC Time.

### **2. Prize**

There is one (1) Prize available to be won through a random draw consisting of:

One (1) \$500 contribution to an SCCU Account.

In no case will SCCU be required to award more prizes than set forth herein, or award a prize other than as specified herein. No cash alternative to the prizes will be offered or provided by SCCU. The prizes are not transferable. Prizes are subject to availability and SCCU reserves the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice.

### **3. Eligibility**

### **5. Selected Entrants Requirements**

- a) Sign a declaration form on behalf of himself or herself:

The Prize is non-transferable, has no cash value and must be accepted as awarded with no substitution except at the sole and absolute discretion of SCCU.
